

Possible Risks, Hazards and Complications

Plasma Fibroblast / Microneedling / Microblade /permanent makeup

Please read each one carefully and initial next to it to indicate understanding:

_____ **Pain:** There can be pain even after the topical anesthetic has been used.
Anesthetics work better on some people than on others.

_____ **Infection:** Infection is very unusual. The areas treated must be kept clean, and only freshly cleaned hands should touch the areas treated. See "Home Care" sheet for instructions on home care.

_____ **Excessive Swelling, water blisters or Bruising:** Some people bruise or swell more than others. In rare cases, water blisters may form following a Plasma Fibroblast procedures. A cool compress with gauze and cold water can be placed on treatment areas to help reduce the swelling. The swelling, water blisters or bruises typically disappear in 1-15 days .

_____ **Anesthetics:** Topical anesthetics are used to numb the area of procedure. Lidocaine, Prilocaine, Benzocaine, Tetracaine, and/or Epinephrine cream and/or liquid are used. If you are allergic to any of these, please inform your technician now.

_____ **hyperpigmentation:** In Rare cases a client might experience post inflammatory hyperpigmentation which might not go away. If you are prone to hyperpigmentation, a test patch is recommended. Please inform your technician if this is the case.

The alternative to these possibilities is to NOT undergo the Plasma Fibroblast / Microneedling / Mesotherapy procedure.
